<b>Method of Qualifying:</b>	Qualifying fee in the amount of <b>\$25.00</b> <b>OR</b> Number of petitions needed: <b>25</b>  The petition form ( <a href="#">DS-DE 104</a> ) may be downloaded from the Division of Elections website. Candidates are responsible for reproducing the petition.  Petitions must be submitted to the Supervisor of Elections office <b>prior to Noon, May 16, 2022</b>
<b>Filing Documents:</b>	*Appointment of Campaign Treasurer and Designation of Campaign Depository ( <a href="#">DS-DE 9</a> ) <b>AND/OR</b> Statement of Candidate ( <a href="#">DS-DE 84</a> )  <i>*Pursuant to 99.061(3) The (DS-DE 9) form only needs to be completed by the candidate if they intend to collect and/or expend money</i>
<b>Qualifying Documents:</b>	Candidate Oath – Non-Partisan Office ( <a href="#">DS-DE 302NP</a> ) <b>AND</b> Form 1 – Statement of Financial Interests 2021
